From there he became an assistant women's volleyball coach at Harvard University before taking over the head position at Holy Cross for six years. Chris also served as the head men's volleyball coach at Harvard for three years. After his college coaching career, Chris has been involved in the club volleyball community in Massachusetts.</p> <p><b>Kristee Porter, Director of Volleyball Operations at Volleyball Factory:</b> Kristee was a four-time All-American at UCLA and was named the <i>Volleyball Magazine</i> National Player of the Year in 2000. She was a member of the USA Volleyball Women's National Team from 2001-2004 and played internationally for Gigantes De Carolina, a professional team in Carolina, Puerto Rico. In addition she's coached at the college level (Navarro Junior College and University of Colorado) and for multiple high school and club volleyball teams.</p>
