As a student in the Washington, DC area Cheryl received numerous awards including: All-Met High School Player of the Year, Gatorade Player of the Year Metro Area for 3 straight years, and USA Today's Fab 50 High School Players. She played her college volleyball at Long Beach State, California where she won a national championship as well as Big West Conference Player of the Year for 3 consecutive years. Cheryl went on to play in many professional volleyball leagues around the world as well as playing for the US National team from 2009-2011.</p> <p>Cassy Marx: Cassy is the Director of Operations at Volleyball Factory. Before coming to the Factory, she was the assistant coach at Cardinal Stritch University for the men and women's volleyball program. While at Stritch, the women's team made school history making it to their first National Tournament appearance. Cassy played her collegiate volleyball at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside. She was primarily positioned as an outside hitter, but also spent time as a right outside hitter and trained as a setter.</p>
